About Women Connect

Women Connect exists to support women in our region who due to life events, limited support networks and feelings of social isolation are seeking to gain a sense of connection, empowerment and self reliance.

Our successful program provides practical resources, information and referrals to meet the employment, further education and social welfare needs of women in our community.

Supported since 2017 by the Phillip Island Community & Learning Centre (PICAL), Women Connect is a well recognised and award winning initiative with strong support from our local community and partner organisations.



How we help

A SPACE TO CONNECT

Women Connect provides a safe and welcoming space that is free to access for all local women. Our modern co-working space is equipped with technology and resources to support women to meet challenges, gain skills and build connections with other local women.

We provide:

- Free access to computers, printers and office resources
- Support from a volunteer to access technology and complete online tasks.
- Employment support services, resume writing and Work Wardrobe outfitting service
- Social Welfare information, referrals, and support to access service providers
- A resource "bank" of skilled volunteers assisting women with free 1:1 appointments to deliver practical and professional support in a range of areas including legal, financial, and small business.
- Material supports including hygiene items and emergency essentials.
- Regular social groups, and community activities that build networks and positive mental wellbeing.
- Education programs and workshops on topics relevant to local women

What we have achieved

SINCE 2017 WOMEN CONNECT HAS

- Provided 2000+ hours access to facilities & resources
- Established regional Victoria's only all-female co-working space
- Assisted over 100 local women to find employment
- Provided more than 50 free Work Wardrobe outfits
- Supported over 20 women to complete further education
- Distributed over 200 Share the Dignity Bags and Backpacks
- Assisted with over 100 referrals to social welfare organisations
- Supported over 25 women to complete TAFE and Tertiary Studies
- Established a free community laundry space for vulnerable women
- Assisted over 40 women to access and use technology through our Tech Club
- Worked closely with a network of 10 other local charity and NFP services
- Attracted a social media following of over 800 people
- Provided 450+ personal hygiene & care packs for vulnerable women in our community

OUR MISSION


To provide resources, programs & services that empower and support women on their journey to employment, personal fulfilment and belonging in our community

OUR VALUES




Analysis & Conclusions


Our future
